It is something new for the LTA and the Clubs; we understand that once the draw has taken place the Clubs complete the online forms, the LTA officially contacts each winning BTM to confirm the cost of the tickets, the member makes payment, presumably cheque or card, and the LTA send the tickets directly to each member.
